## PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING NOMINATIONS FOR THE WEST VIRGINIA STATE USBC HALL OF FAME

If you are interested in submitting a name for the West Virginia State USBC Hall of Fame, nomination forms can be printed at www.bowlwv.com. Please submit completed form to Tammy Martin Hall of Fame Committee Chair 208 Ridgeway Drive, Bluefield, VA 24605, telephone (304) 921-6756. The forms must be completed and postmarked no later than August 1st.

Anyone may submit nominations in either of the two categories - SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE or MERITORIOUS SERVICE. Basic qualifications are listed at the top of the nomination form. Additional sheets of information may be attached.

Nominations are reviewed by the West Virginia State USBC Hall of Fame Committee and final selections are made by the West Virginia State USBC Board of Directors and Delegation at the Spring meeting. Information submitted for the persons not selected will be kept in the Committee's active file for Three (3) years. This means nominees will automatically be reconsidered annually and it will not be necessary to submit new nomination forms annually. After the third year the nomination would need to be re-submitted.

## POLICY

1. A bowler may be elected only once to the West Virginia State USBC Hall of Fame, regardless of the category.
2. West Virginia State USBC will announce the current recipients of the Hall of Fame awards immediately following their selection at the spring meeting of the WV State USBC Board of Directors and Delegation.

## VOTING PROCEDURES MERITORIOUS SERVICE \& SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE

1. The Hall of Fame Committee will present a list of candidates for consideration to the Board of Directors and Delegates, not more than 6 Men and 6 Women in each category (possible total of 24 candidates).
2. Voting will be held by Category (Meritorious or Superior).
3. Nominee can only be placed into one of the Categories. A Nominee can be Elected only once for the Hall of Fame regardless of the category.
4. Voting will be by ballot vote and requires a $2 / 3^{\text {rd' }}$ s vote to be elected. If $2 / 3$ rds is not reached after (3) attempts no one will be elected.
5. Possible inductees may be 2 (Men), 2 (Women) or 1 (Man) and 1 (Women) no more than two inductees per year.
